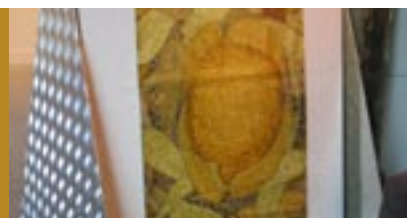
Michael Nelson Jagamarra

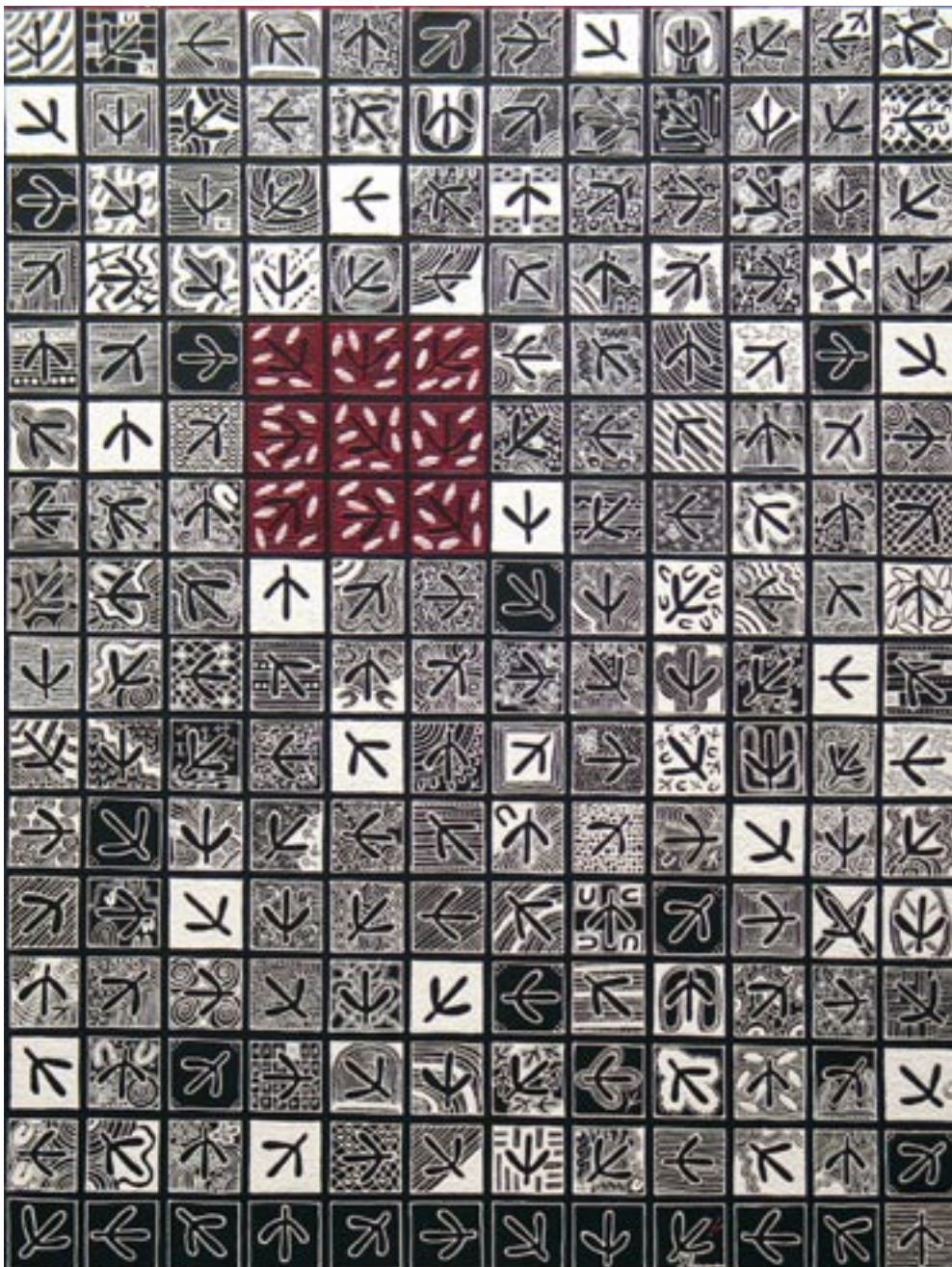
Peter Overs

The larger of the 2 is possibly the best that Peter has done and the detail provides new imagery to view every day of the year. The wealth of knowledge of his grandfather's country around Dirranbandi in south west Queensland is expressed in amazing detail.
