Sculptural Material

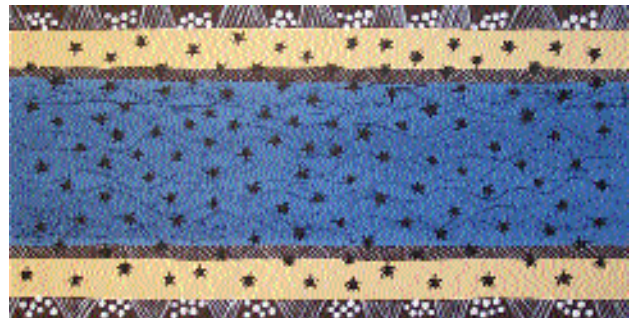
