
Resale royalty

June 9 heralds the introduction of the Resale Royalty where the sale of works of art may be subject to a 5% royalty charge. 90% of that fee will be reimbursed to the artist by the collection agency CAL. Art Mob believes that this legislation was introduced without appropriate industry consultation and what has resulted is quite different to a secondary market resale royalty which would generally have been more acceptable. Non-compliance can result in a draconian \$125,000 fine!


