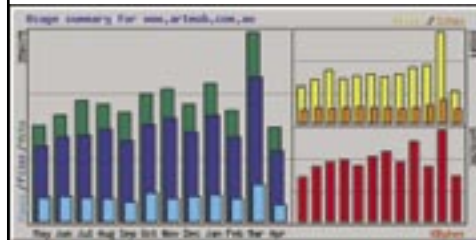

Complementary Colours

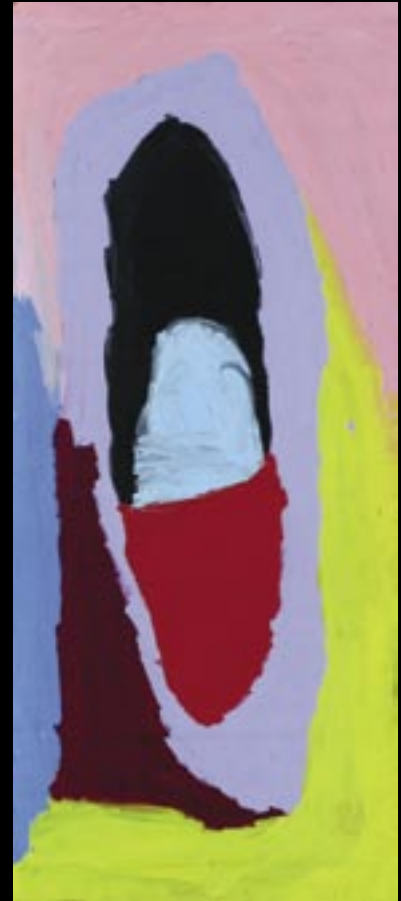
Ci Simon across the IXL Atrium from Art Mob rehung their space with new paintings to complement winter/spring fashion colours.

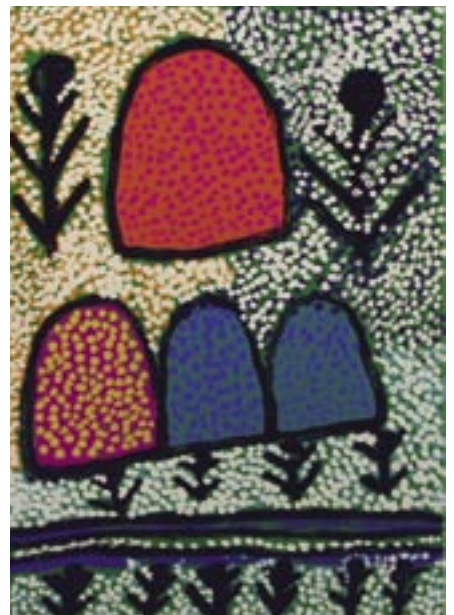
