Eylandt art

Now there are at least 3 historic connections between Groote Eylandt & Tasmania. In 1642 Abel Tasman named Van Diemen's Land - now Tasmania. Continuing his journey in 1644 he named Groote Eylandt in the Gulf of Carpentaria. In 1803 Matthew Flinders on his circumnavigation of Australia, after circumnavigating VDL, discovered a heavy black rock at Groote that he thought was ironstone. 2 million tons of this manganese ore are now exported annually from the island. Now, yet another 200 or so years later, Art Mob creates more history by hosting the very first group exhibition of Groote Eylandt art work with "Eylandt to Island" in conjunction with Anindilyakwa Arts. The basketry and dilly bags in particular are very special!
